The year ahead

2020

We will open on the 13th January 2020.

We will be closed from the 10th to the 13th April for Easter.

We will be closed on the 27th April 2020.

We will be closed on the 1st May 2020.

We will be closed on the 15th and the 16th June 2020.

We will be closed on the 10th August 2020.

We will be closed on the 24th and the 25th September 2020.

We will be closing for December holidays on the 11th December 2020 at 12:00.

Fees

Fees are paid over a 12 month period.

Fees are expected to be paid in advance and no later than the 4th of a month.

The fees for 2020 are as follows:

- Full day with breakfast, lunch and snacks provided – R2500
- Half day with breakfast, lunch and snacks provided – R2100
- 3 days a week with breakfast, lunch and snacks provided – R1500
- Aftercare with a snack and homework assistance – R1200
- Aftercare with one on one extra lessons – R1500

A **non-refundable registration fee** of R300 will be charged per child on entry to Little Munchkins Preschool and Aftercare.

If you are later than 5:30 to come and pick up your child, penalty fees will be added to you next months fees. A fee of R25 for every 5 minutes after the above specified time.

Birthdays

Birthdays are an important part of your child's life. I will liaise with you about a suitable day and time for you to attend the birthday ring. Please share this special moment with your child. It will be appreciated if you could donate a book, old or new, for our library. Cupcakes are an ideal snack, as it is easy to hand out to the class.

Medical

If your child is ill, please ensure that he/she is cared for at home. It is unfair to both the ill child and other children in the class if an ill child is present at school.

If your child falls ill whilst at school, I will advise you on your child's condition. You will be notified whether your child needs to be taken home or to a doctor.

Your child's temperature will be taken if he/she becomes unwell at school. Parents will be notified when their child's temperature is over 37,5 degrees.

It is important that Little Munchkins is advised in writing as to whether your child has any allergies or medical problems.

All details regarding any allergies that you know your child may suffer from must be detailed on the registration form and discussed with the principal i.e specific food allergies, medication, latex or plaster, bees, grass or pollen allergies.

If your child has asthma, please ensure your child has their asthma pump at school every day and that they know when and how to use it.

Medication that needs to be given to your child, needs to be clearly explained in writing about how much, how often etc. only then will it be given to your child.

Fundraisers

Tuckshop

Tuckshop will be available on a Friday. Children need to bring R10. It will include a packet of chips and an ice cream. During the winter months it will be a packet of chips and a chocolate.



Mini walk / sports day

This will be done at the end of the year.

General

- Discourage your child from bringing toys from home, there are always tears if the toys are lost or broken and often cause fights between the children. We have plenty of exciting toys at school.
- Sun hats are a necessity. Please ensure that your child's hat is sent to school daily.
- Please send suntan cream with your child daily. Please make sure it is marked clearly with their name.
- All your child's possessions need to be clearly marked with your child's name on them.
- Please send a change of clothes to school for your child every day, as accidents can, and do happen.
- The school can not be held responsible for any lost items.
- Tuck shop for the children will be every Friday. Please give your child R5 so as to buy what they wish.
- You can pack your child something to snack on for the morning. Lunch will not be provided. Cold drink and a small snack will be provided. Snacks will be a yoghurt or fruit or a biscuit.
- The following should be inside your child's bag daily:
 - Wet wipes (if not potty trained yet)
 - Nappies preferably pull ups so potty training is a lot easier
 - Bum cream
 - Change clothes
 - Hat
 - Suntan cream
 - A healthy snack and water bottle

Stationery list

Please can the following be brought once a year:

- Box of crayons
- Play dough
- Ponal wood glue
- One pack of coloured cardboard

Please can the following be brought in every term:

- 3 toilet rolls
- 2 packs of wet wipes
- 1 liquid hand soap
- 1 box of tissues

Please can all the items on the stationery list be brought to school as above.



Extra mural activities

Little Munchkins offers the following extra mural activities during school time:

- **Swimming**

- **Playball**
Children develop co-ordination skills as well as a beginning knowledge of all sports that might be part of a primary school curriculum. They come once a week on a Wednesday from 11:00. This is a compulsory extra mural that all my kids at Little Munchkins needs to take part in.
- **Tiny Twisters Gymnastics**
This is a start to artistic as well as tumbling gymnastics. It is usually once a week on a Wednesday morning.

Extra mural activities are not covered by your school fees and it is up to you to pay the amount per month.

Aftercare facilities

- All children to bring their own stationery to aftercare.
- Please give your child another snack as only a snack will be given to them on arrival.
- Please if all children can also bring 3 rolls of toilet paper every term.
- During the holidays, the fee for Atercare will go up to R1500 for that month.
